THE HOST, (BLESSED BAKER) IS WEARING AN APRON AND STANDING BEHIND A LONG TABLE WITH COOKING INGREDIENTS AND UTENSILS AND A LARGE BOWL.

THE BLESSED BAKER

Hello and welcome to the Blessed Baker
Show. My name is Amber and I'm your
Blessed Baker. Today we are going to
bake one of my favorite deserts; a "Life
Cake." Now this is one of my special
recipes because although it may not look
like much when we start, it's going to
be a blessing when we finish.

THE BAKER GRAB A LARGE BOWL AND BEGINS MIXING THE INGREDIENTS.

Okay, first we take 2 eggs AND SOME BAD NEWS.

Next, pour in about a ½ cup of flour AND YOUR FAMILY PROBLEMS (adlib, e.g., and we all have problems, etc.)
