TOP PRIORITY

INT. FAMILY ROOM - EVENING

BILL AND MARY ARE RETURNING HOME FROM A FAMILY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM AT THE CHURCH. THEY ENTER THE FRONT DOOR (OR APPROACH THE STAGE) AND WALK INTO THE FAMILY ROOM.

MARY

(upset)

I can't believe you said that.

BILL

What?

MARY

What you said.

BILL

What did I say that was so wrong?

MARY

When you were asked the question, "How many types of each animal did Moses take on the Ark?", What did you say?

BILL

Two. One male and one female.

MARY

(disgusted)

No silly, the answer is none, zero, zilch. Noah built the ark, not Moses!

BILL

(down playing it)

Noah...Moses, what's the big deal.

MARY

The big deal is that it's wrong, and that caused us to lose the game.

BILL

Look, I just wanted to eat. You are the one that wanted to play Bible Trivia.

MARY

Bill, it was family night at the church and we never participate in the games. BILL PLOPS DOWN ON THE SOFA TO RELAX.

BILL

So. (beat) By the way, you got buzzed too...Ms. Bible Scholar.

MARY

I...I was just confused, that's all.

BILL

What was your question? (thinking) Oh yeah, "Who were Abraham, Issac, and Jacob", and what was your answer?

MARY

(embarrassed)

Jesus' disciples.

BILL

That's the most ridiculous answer in the world. No wonder you were buzzed. Everyone knows they were the three Hebrew boys thrown into the furnace!

MARY

Well, I knew they were somebody important. (pause) I guess we both have a lot to learn. We really need to study the bible more.

BILL

I know, but we don't have time.

MARY

(Determined)

Well, we need to make time!

MARY OPENS THE CALENDAR IN HER SMARTPHONE.

Come on, let's schedule time now.

BILL

(Dumbfounded)

Duh....If I don't have time to do something, then why make a schedule to do what I don't have time to do.

MARY

W(ith disregard)

BILL

BILL
