INT. OFFICE WAITING (LOUNGE) AREA

(Ad-lib small talk as they enter)

Just have a seat Mr. Walters. Let me check to see if the manager is ready for you. Do you have a resume?

JAMES

Oh yes. (Hands Secretary his resume)

SECRETARY

Great. I'll just be a moment.

SECRETARY EXITS

JAMES AND BAD HABIT SIT DOWN. JAMES TAKES THE MIDDLE SEAT.

JAMES

(Nervously rubbing hands together) Man, my wife and I have been praying I get this job.

BAD HABIT

Me too. I wonder what time you'll need to be at work. You know we like to sleep late.

JAMES

Yeah, but I gotta do better. I lost my last job because I was always late.
