Cast

Father - Male (30-40)Mother - Female (30-40)

Angel - Female (Adult - any age)

Son 1 - Male (7-10)Son 2 - Male (7-10)

Costumes

Parents - normal daily wear Angel - white dress, scarf, and hat Boys - in biblical Shepherd costumes

Props

Shepherd staffs Bologna sandwich Bottle of Diet Coke

Time: 10-15 minutes

THE CHRISTMAS ENCOUNTER

INT. HOME

The family is returning home from church. The children (2 boys) are still dressed in their Christmas costumes (Shepherds).

FAMILY ENTERS

BOYS RUN IN FIRST FOLLOWED BY PARENTS. BOYS ARE EXCITED, JUMPING AROUND, AND PLAYING WITH THEIR SHEPHERD STAFFS.

MOTHER

Alright...alright, calm down, the

Christmas play is over. Hey, don't tear

those costumes. (Sarcastically) Sister

Johnson will have a fit!

MOTHER AND FATHER PROCEED TO TAKE OFF THEIR COATS

SON 1

(Excited, speaking to his brother) It's Christmas Eve; let's try to find the Christmas Star!

THE BOYS RUSH OVER TO LOOK OUT THE WINDOW

SON 2

Look, there it is!

SON 1

Where?

SON 2

Over there!

SON 1

I can't see it. Let's open the window.

BOYS ATTEMPT TO OPEN WINDOW

FATHER

Hey, hey, you better not open that window. Its 30 degrees outside.

MOTHER

Come on boys, take off your costumes and get ready for bed. Santa Claus is coming tonight!

FATHER

(To Wife) Santa...really?

MOTHER

Hush! Let them have their fun.

MOTHER SITS DOWN ON THE SOFA AND TAKES OFF HER SHOES TO SETTLE IN.

MOTHER (CONT'D)

Wasn't that a great play? I just love seeing the Christmas story re-enacted. The baby Jesus lying in a manger; the Shepherds and Wise Men coming to worship the newborn King.

FATHER

(Grumpy) It was a long play, and I was hungry. They could have fed us.

FATHER WALKS INTO THE KITCHEN TO PREPARE A SANDWICH

MOTHER

It was a Christmas Play, not a Christmas Dinner!

FATHER

They have that same old play every year.

Now our boys believe in Shining Stars
and Santa.

MOTHER

Now Kevin, you know that's not the same. FATHER RETURNS WITH A SANDWICH AND A BOTTLE OF DIET COKE

FATHER

Sure it is. C'mon now, you don't believe all that Christmas stuff, do you?

MOTHER

(Defensive) I certainly do believe in the birth of Christ!

FATHER

(Calms her down) No, I'm not talking about the birth. I'm talking about all that other stuff.

MOTHER

Like what!?

FATHER

You know, (dramatic) an Angel coming from Heaven to speak to the Shepherd Men, A big shining star in the sky; the Wise Men walking hundreds of miles to find a baby child. C'mon, it's all a lot of hype to embellish the birth of Christ.

MOTHER

Father, I'm not getting into an argument with you tonight. You're not going to dampen my Spirit.

FATHER

Well, what proof do you have that any of that stuff really happened?

MOTHER (O.S.)

God said it...I believe it...and that settles it!

MOTHER (O.S.) (CONT'D)

SFX - DOOR BELL RINGS

FATHER CONTINUES TO MUSE ABOUT HOW CRAZY THE STORY IS AS HE GOES TO OPEN THE DOOR.

A WOMAN, WEARING A WHITE DRESS, WHITE SCARF, AND A LARGE BRIM WHITE HAT IS STANDING AT THE DOOR.

FATHER (CONT'D)

Hello

ANGEL

Hello Kevin, may I come in?

FATHER

Sure, c'mon in.

ANGEL ENTERS

FATHER (CONT'D)

You must be a member of the church. We enjoyed the play, however my wife just went upstairs to go to bed.

ANGEL

Oh, I'm not here <u>for</u> your wife. I'm here <u>for</u> you.

FATHER

Me! Well, who are you?

ANGEL

I'm the Angel whom God sent to proclaim the birth of Christ to the Shepherds over 2000 years ago.

FATHER PAUSES FOR A MOMENT, THEN BURSTS INTO LAUGHTER.

FATHER

Yeah, right. (Looking around) Am I being "Punked". Did my wife put you up to this? Where are the cameras?

ANGEL

No, you're not being "Punked". God heard you doubting the events surrounding the birth of Jesus, so He sent me here to speak to you.
